Chairman McGrath is concerned that the County will not accept what was submitted and feels that the board needs plans to be drawn up by an engineer as that is what was submitted by prior applicants. The Chairman contacted

John Howland via phone to obtain his feedback. ZEO Howland stated that it doesn't have to be sent to the County Health Department for any approvals and that prior applicants just had theirs drawn by an engineer, they didn't have to. He does feel the applicant should supply a better site plan that has true dimensions and is more to scale with set backs. He will help her create a better drawing to submit to the County.
