### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

# **VARIANCE APPLICATION:**

Application #24-61 A motion was made by Kaczmar and seconded by Skotnicki to open the public hearing at 6:32 p.m. All members were in favor. The application was submitted by Lucas Andrade of River View Rd. The applicant would like to split one property into two properties. Mr. Howland mentioned that the applicant resides out of state. There was a lengthy discussion regarding the types of lot sales permitted with this variance, due to limited space in the area. A motion was made by Skotnicki seconded by Kaczmar to close the public hearing at 6:53 p.m. All members were in favor.
