- GIS-based Community Resource Inventory was mentioned in the first paragraph. There will be a follow up with Tug Hill Commission to see if one has been done for the Town and Village.

- In paragraph a, Dawn will see if the Oswego County's Agricultural and Open Space Protection Program is still in existence.

- b. Jan will See if the endangered frog is still be protected. It's habitat is by the current Bethel Center.

- c. The page number will change in the final document.

- d. Include Watershed information from the yearly meeting of the Watershed Protection Committee.

Page 201

- The page number will change on letter f

- Letter l will have language that states an ADA Compliant access to the Salmon River is needed in the Village.

- Letter j will have the phrase "where applicable" added at the end of the paragraph

Page 202

- the caption under the illustration will be deleted.

- Letter a will have a page number change in the final document.

- Letter b will have the word "Toothpick" deleted and the following added, "now know as the Bethel Community Center".

Page 203

- In the first paragraph, Pine Grove will be added in the second sentence.
- In letter a, after the word Selkirk the following will be put in parentheses " by the Light House".
- Letter f will have Richland Recreation Association deleted.

Under picture updates, Dawn mentioned she needed a current one of the Arches. Jan will email that to Dawn. Also on page 73, Connex Care needs to be rewritten.

Other Old Business

The R.I.V.E.R. draft document was discussed briefly.

New Business

The Town is hoping to finish up the updated campground regulations. The Village is still waiting for the State to present contracts and further information on the DRI Award. The Village has also updated the Rental Registration Law.
